

Required closed toe shoes and khakis, clear bag and snacks can be brought in; pizza and fountain drinks will be supplied.

Gillette supplies visor and dark blue polo; you can wear layers dress for the weather (you can wear your own hat IF Gillette affiliate ex. Patriots hat)

Driving in via carpool – arrive at BMR at the designated carpool time with printed parking pass OR downloaded pass on cell phone and take one of three routes (see directions sheet) into the employee parking area. Once received by Gillette a map, the parking pass, booth location and parking area will be emailed to all volunteers the week of the event.

Driving in on your own – ensure to arrive at least 10 minutes before Gillette check in time; A map, the parking pass, booth location and parking area is supplied by Gillette and will be emailed to all volunteers the week of the event once received.

What to do upon arriving –

- For a Patriots game or concert we typically park in Employee Lot B.
- Once you arrive, there are shuttle busses that you take up to the check in point. (all busses go to the same location so you don't have to worry about which one you jump on)
- Once you exit the shuttle go up the driveway to the right where you will find an entrance on the far right side for employees and volunteers
- Continue straight and you will see the security check (if you are the person in charge/ banker you will have the bin and maybe asked what is in it, it's okay to tell them kitchen and working booth supplies)
- Once passing through the security section go through the doors staying to the right side for volunteers and head to the lane A-B. Let the check in counter know that you are with BMMA and they will then give you a wristband. Keep the wristband on the

ENTIRE time; if it falls off get another one or try to tape it on.

- Once you have your wristband head to the booth. If working IS127 or IS 134 (IS=Italian Sausage) head to the left once passing through the other side of the gate. Look for the booth designation and Italian Sausage for example and at the entrance of those booths is the number to the booth.
- For a Revolution soccer game or other smaller event, you park closer so there is no shuttle running. For these events, we park practically at the entrance and can walk over to the check in area. From there follow the same steps as above.

What about when I leave?

When you leave, you will be directed directly to route 140 if during a Patriots game or concert. Typically, you take a right if you came from the Blackstone Millville area, your GPS will pick up from there. If a Revolution game, just follow GPS out to your preferred route from the main parking lot.

Checking in

Once through security you are on ground level booths to a left towards our typical booths
